## About Pertanika Journals

*Pertanika* is the only official hall-mark journal of Universiti Putra Malaysia. It is a multidisciplinary peer-reviewed leading journal in Malaysia which began publication in 1978. In 1992, *Pertanika* diversified and turned into three specialized journals as the Journal of Tropical Agricultural Science (JTAS), Journal of Science and Technology (JST), and Journal of Social Sciences & Humanities (JSSH) to meet the need for specialized journals in areas of study aligned with the interdisciplinary strengths of the university.

The journals cater for scientists, professors, researchers, post-docs, scholars and students who wish to promote and communicate advances in the fields of Agriculture, Science & Technology, and Social Sciences & Humanities research through its three titles; JTAS, JST & JSSH.

All three *Pertanika* titles are accepted and published in **English** and are open to authors around the world regardless of the nationality.

Each title is currently published two times a year; JST is published in **January** and **July** while JTAS in **February** and **August**, and JSSH is published in **March** and **September**.

All three titles are indexed in **EBSCO**. JTAS and JSSH are also indexed in **SCOPUS** (Elsevier) and **CABI**. In addition, JTAS is also indexed in **AGRICOLA**.

## Scope of the Journals

Journal of Tropical Agricultural Science aims to provide a forum for high quality research related to tropical agricultural research. Areas relevant to the scope of the journal include: *agricultural biotechnology, biochemistry, biology, ecology, fisheries, forestry, food sciences, entomology, genetics, microbiology, pathology and management, physiology, plant and animal sciences, production of plants and animals of economic importance, and veterinary medicine*. The journal publishes original academic articles dealing with research on issues of worldwide relevance.

Journal of Science & Technology caters for science and engineering research. Areas relevant to the scope of the journal include: *bioinformatics; bioscience; biotechnology and bio-molecular sciences; chemistry; computer science; ecology; engineering; engineering design; environmental control and management; mathematics and statistics; medicine and health sciences; nanotechnology; physics; safety and emergency management, or related fields of study*.

The journal publishes original academic articles dealing with research on issues of worldwide relevance.

Journal of Social Sciences & Humanities deals in research or theories in social sciences and humanities



research. Areas relevant to the scope of the journal include: *accounting; agricultural and resource economics; anthropology; business studies; communications; community and studies; design and disaster and crisis management; education; language language acquisition; studies; finance; human ecology; management; modern languages; safety and environment; social behavioural and sociology.*

*peace architecture; economics; education; extension gerontology; humanities; marketing; psychology; and sciences;*

JSSH aims to develop as a flagship journal for the Social Sciences with a focus on emerging issues pertaining to the social and behavioural sciences as well as the humanities, particularly in the Asia Pacific region.

## Paper Submission Instructions

For the **two** 2011 issues, papers must be submitted only via the **Executive Editor's office**. Please feel free to contact the executive editor at [ndeeps@admin.upm.edu.my](mailto:ndeeps@admin.upm.edu.my) for guidance on the Online submission process.

Articles may be either full research papers (maximum 6000 words), or as short communications (maximum 2000 words), or review papers (maximum 4000 words). After submissions are accepted, papers will follow blind

peer-review process by selected members of the editorial board and reviewers from an international pool for quality, consistency and research contribution. Authors are welcome to nominate up to three reviewers when submitting their paper using the prescribed form.

Articles submitted to this journal must contain original results and must not be submitted elsewhere while being evaluated for the Journal of Tropical Agricultural Science.

Articles should be double-spaced 12 point type (Arial or Times New Roman fonts preferred). The **first** page should only contain the running title of the article.

The **second** page should include the full title of the article and the names and contact information of all authors. It should clearly state the corresponding author. The names of the authors must be abbreviated following the



international naming convention.

e.g. *Salleh, A.B., Tan, S.G., or Sapuan, S.M.*

The **third** page should repeat the full title of the article and contain the abstract and keywords but no author information. Page **four** onwards should contain the introduction and the rest of the article.

Articles along with the **submission forms** (Declaration, Scope and Ref A forms) and a **cover letter** may be submitted electronically as e-mail attachments in either MSWord or RTF file formats to [ndeeps@admin.upm.edu.my](mailto:ndeeps@admin.upm.edu.my). Questions regarding submissions should be directed to the same address.

One key request of researchers across the world is unrestricted access to research publications. *Pertanika* gives a worldwide audience larger than that of any subscription-based journal and thus increases the visibility and impact of published works as it is fully committed to the Open Access Initiative and will provide free access to all articles as soon as they are published.
