The Selection Committee, LUND UNIVERSITY LIBRARIES, Sweden has selected all **Pertanika Journals** to be included in **DOAJ** (Directory of Open Access Journals) effective November 2011.

In addition, Pertanika Journals are indexed in **SCOPUS** (Elsevier), and **EBSCO**. JTAS is also indexed in AGRICOLA and CABI.
